Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men (CCBCM)	\$10,000	Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men (CCBCM) will use grant funds to support its two major programs in providing scholarships to Prince George's County high school seniors and to provide food and monetary donations to families in need of assistance that live in the county. Funds will also be used to provide COVID-19 financial assistance.
GapBuster	\$10,000	GapBuster will use grant funds for their Workforce Development and Employment services targeting reentry and opportunity (disconnected) youth ages 16 to 24 and mothers who are under/unemployed living under the poverty line.
Operation Earnie's Plate Inc	\$3,000	Operation Earnie's Plate Inc Mobile Food Pantry will use grant funds to continue to provide groceries, hot meals, and basic living necessities to people experiencing homelessness in our community (particularly District 6): seniors, veterans, youth, and adults. Including providing Thanksgiving boxes to residents of District 6.
The Training Source, Inc.	\$3,677	The Training Source, Inc. will use grant funds for general operating support for adult job training; youth leadership; youth job readiness; college and career planning; community support services (SNAP application assistance, domestic violence survivor support etc.); employer staffing and training etc.
