| Coalition for Public Safety Training in Schools, Inc. | \$5,000 | Coalition for Public Safety Training in Schools, Inc. will use grant funds to offer services to youth, including driver education scholarships, a summer internship, leadership development, and a Electrical Pre-Apprenticeship to enhance workforce development and improve quality of life. |
| Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men (CCBCM) | \$5,000 | Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men (CCBCM) will use grant funds to support its two major programs in providing scholarships to Prince George's County high school seniors and to provide food and monetary donations to families in need of assistance that live in the county. Funds will also be used to provide COVID-19 financial assistance. |
| ecoLatinos | \$2,500 | ecoLatinos will use grant funds to survey Latino and other minority constituents from each council district on their perceived needs around climate change, environment, health, etc. |
| Hope Connections for Cancer Support, Inc. | \$3,500 | Hope Connections for Cancer Support, Inc. will use grant funds to help people with cancer and their loved ones deal with the social, emotional, and physical impact of cancer through professionally facilitated programs of emotional support, education, wellness and hope. |
| Ivy Community Charities of Prince George's County, Inc. | \$5,000 | Ivy Community Charities will use grant funds to provide scholarships to students who reside in or attend a school in District 8, with awards to high school students entering college in the Fall of 2023/Spring 2024. Continuing or returning college students may be awarded scholarships. |
| Joan's House | \$53,500 | Joan's House will use grant funds to install approximately 135 camera systems in District 8 of Prince George's County as a part of the Jaye Agnew Program in order to combat crime in the area. |
| Judge Me Now Literacy & STEAM Resources, Inc. | \$5,000 | Judge me Now Literacy & Steam Resources, Inc. will use grant funds to support teachers and students in District 1 to to celebrate them for their hard work. Students will be awarded at our Annual High School Seniors Day with scholarships for serving their community and their academics. |
