Alice Ferguson Foundation	\$27,000	Alice Ferguson Foundation will partner with another Prince George's County non-profit, Manhood 101, and use grant funds to deliver a four-day, outdoor summer camp experience to 50 at-risk 7th - 12th grade Prince George's County boys.
Bishop McNamara High School	\$5,000	Bishop McNamara High School will use grant funds for their Family Support Fund, helping PGC students with fees, tuition, and food assistance so they can continue their education uninterrupted.
Coalition for African Americans in Performing Arts	\$5,000	Coalition for African Americans in Performing Arts will use grant funds to provide support to sustain, maintain, and advance county-wide programming at the CAAPA Cultural Center, which houses the Arts Academy, WoW (WithOutWords) Deaf Arts, 60+ARTS (Active Retired Talented Seniors), CAAPA C.A.M.P.S.
Coalition for Public Safety Training In Schools, Inc	\$15,000	Coalition for Public Safety Training in Schools will use grant funds to develop an electrical pre-apprenticeship program and provide services driver education scholarships to PGCPs Fire Science cadets and Career and Technical Education (CTE) students.
Coalition for Stronger Communities	\$22,500	Coalition for Stronger Communities will use grant funds to support a college and scholarship preparatory program for high school students and a STEM program for middle school students.
E V O L V E, Inc.	\$12,500	EVOLVE, Inc. will use grant funds to provide food to kids and families experiencing food insecurity, especially at Thanksgiving; provide shopping experience for warm clothing for kids/families in need; to support mental & behavioral health programs; for youth sports programs; and to generally support operations.
First Generation College Bound, Inc.	\$1,000	First Generation College Bound, Inc. will use grant funds to provide support to the general operating support in FY24, to include program activities, telecommunications, technology, and salaries.
Kappa Foundation of Fort Washington	\$22,500	Kappa Foundation of Fort Washington will use grant funds to provide a scholarship to a disadvantaged male youth in District 9 and the greater surrounding area.
Love & Warmth Foundation	\$4,000	Love & Warmth Foundation will utilize grant funds to support the Annual Coat and Food Distribution Program, specifically targeting underserved families in District Nine.
