## Checklist for FY2026 County Council Grant Request Letters:

- ✓ The formal Letter of Consideration should be no more than 2 pages in length and must be written on the organization's letterhead.
- ✓ Identify the amount of grant funding requested in the first paragraph.
- ✓ Provide justification to demonstrate the need of the funds being requested.
- ✓ Summarize how the proposed funding will be used to address the identified needs.
- ✓ Use this address for the header of the letter:
