Organization Name	Amount Entered when approved only	Grant Purpose
Bishop McNamara High School	\$5,000	Bishop McNamara High School, Inc. will use the grant funds to provide essential assistance to students whose families are facing financial hardship. Funds will help cover critical expenses such as tuition, student fees, books, SAT/ACT workshops or testing fees-ensuring that students can continue their education.
Blake Bozeman Foundation	\$20,000	Blake Bozeman Foundation will use grant funds to support youth development programs through sports, financial literacy, mental health communication and community service initiatives in countywide- Prince George's.
Coalition for Public Safety Training in Schools, Inc.	\$20,000	Coalition for Public Safety Training in Schools, Inc. (CPSTS) will use grant funds to educate, advocate and foster career training in schools and support workforce development for the benefit of the local community. CPSTS will provide technical training opportunities.
Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men	\$10,000	Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men (CCBCM) will use grant funds to support our two major programs in providing annual scholarships to Prince George's County high school seniors and to provide food and monetary donations to persons in need of assistance that live in the county.
Just Us Initiative	\$10,000	Just Us Initiative will use the grant funds to support our efforts by hosting two successful programs (Just Listen) Listening Sessions and JustUs Transitions. Both are designed to provide wrap around services, mentoring and support to Prince George's County youth.
Old School Boxing Athletic Center, Inc.	\$10,000	Old School Boxing Athletic Center, Inc. will use grant funds to offset the cost of rent and enable Old School Boxing to continue supporting the youth in their community.
Re-Entry Roundtable for Prince George's County	\$25,000	Re-Entry Roundtable for Prince George's County will use the grant funds for interim facility rental support to provide intake area, needs assessment, and supplement wrap-around services for adult male returning citizens. Also, to fund the due diligence assessment of a facility to purchase that will include temporary supportive housing.
