<a href="#">Coalition for African Americans in the Performing Arts</a>	\$10,000	Coalition for African Americans in the Performing Arts (CAAPA) will use grant funds to bridge the accessibility gap in performing arts, bringing transformative cultural expression to underserved residents of Prince George's County.
<a href="#">Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men</a>	\$10,000	Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men (CCBCM) will use grant funds to support our two major programs in providing annual scholarships to Prince George's County high school seniors and to provide food and monetary donations to persons in need of assistance that live in the county.
<a href="#">Joan's House, Inc.</a>	\$47,000	Joan's House, Inc. will use grant funds to provide community development services to our local residents of District 8. It will give us the opportunity to host community service events and assist residents who have faced hardship this year.
<a href="#">Junior League of Prince George's County Inc.</a>	\$2,000	Junior League of Prince Georges County is empowering Prince George's County women by helping them develop civic leadership skills, giving them the tools to put their unique talents to work in our community, and working with youth especially around literacy.
