**Welcome (CM Dernoga)****Attendance -** Have quorum.**Recap of Last Meeting****Discussion:**

The meeting commenced with the approval of the previous minutes. Mr. Weiss motioned for the approval, and Ms. Hoban seconded it. Following this, Deputy Director Derrick Coley was introduced as the representative from the County Department of Environment on the Task Force.

The second part of the meeting featured a presentation on Public Facility Adequacy and Police Response Times by Director Hull and Mr. Tyson. During this segment, questions were raised concerning public safety surcharge fees and mitigation fees, as well as the Fiscal Impact Study. Discussions focused on the proposed methodology based on staffing versus response times and the calculation of these fees. Additionally, attendees explored case law and its relevance to development projects.

The final part of the meeting reviewed and discussed the recommendations report, focusing on future conversations about environmental justice and the possibility of aligning the report with the fiscal year instead of the calendar year. The meeting concluded with a motion to accept the report as it was drafted and to discuss the work plan in the next meeting.
