**Recap of Last Meeting**

**Discussion:**

The meeting commenced with the approval of the previous minutes. Mr. Weiss motioned for the approval, and Ms. Riley seconded it. CM Dernoga announced the wrap-up of the taskforce in order to transition to the Plan 2050, and the November meeting would be the last meeting to discuss the accomplishments of Plan 2035 Implementation and Infrastructure Task Force.

The second part of the meeting included a presentation on the "Plan Prince George's 2035 Second Five-Year Evaluation" report, delivered by Director Hull and Mr. Lester. During this segment, taskforce members raised questions regarding established communities, employment areas, Taxbase per capita, and vehicle miles traveled, as well as the sources of the data presented and the methodology used. The discussion also highlighted the backlog of unfunded infrastructure and its connection to the upcoming fiscal impact study. Director Hull concluded by stating that the Department will continue to monitor the indicators that performed poorly on the scorecard and include them in the future planning process for Plan 2050. To ensure enforceability, the Department will research peer jurisdictions to hold their partner agencies accountable during the engagement phase of Plan 2050.

There were questions posed by taskforce members that the Planning Department did not fully answer. In response, the Department will prepare a memo addressing these questions, which will be sent to Council Member Dernoga for distribution.
