Welcome (CM Dernoga)

Attendance - No quorum.

Recap of Last Meeting

Discussion:

The meeting began with a review of the previous meeting minutes, which could not be approved due to the lack of a quorum. This was followed by a wrap-up presentation by Director Hull. The presentation included a recap of the Task Force's purpose pursuant to CR-081-2023, a summary of the topics covered in 2025, and an overview of the next steps to dissolve the Task Force and begin discussions regarding the formation of a future Plan 2050 Task Force.

CM Dernoga raised questions regarding Plan 2050 and lessons learned from Envision Prince George's. Director Hull noted that the Planning Department is currently conducting peer jurisdiction research to identify best practices for community engagement.

Council Member Dernoga thanked the Task Force members for their participation and contributions, noting that the group held many productive meetings and addressed a wide range of topics beyond those listed under miscellaneous items. He also commented on the Planning Department staff's presentation at the previous meeting regarding inflow and outflow vehicle patterns in the County.

Mr. Weiss noted that Plan 2035 remains in effect until a new plan is adopted. Council Member Dernoga further emphasized the importance of reviewing employment trend indicators and comparing tax base per capita with other jurisdictions to better understand the County's industry composition and major employers. Mr. Brigham concluded by emphasizing the need to include underserved neighborhoods and historically marginalized communities in the early community engagement efforts for the future Plan 2050.
