Coalition for African Americans in the Performing Arts (CAAPA)	\$2,222	Coalition for African Americans in the Performing Arts will use grant funds for expenses related to developing and implementing The Performance Series for families, students and children of all ages, with a focus on the "Figaro Meets Frederick Douglass Concert."
Human Services Coalition of Prince George's County, dba Nonprofit Prince George's County	\$1,000	Grant funds will be used for the Sponsoring Ideas & Info Luncheon that provide training on a variety of topics, including; strategic planning, program evaluation, foundation funding opportunities, grant writing and media messaging. Provide training, technical assistance and coaching to 3-4 County nonprofits on the Standards for Excellence code (SFE). NPGC will provide individual support for nonprofits interested in submitting an application SFE Basics, Basics Enhanced or Accreditation. Facilitate up to 5 Affinity group meetings to encourage the development of partnerships to better address issues related to mental health services, workforce development and youth and family services.
