<a href="#"><u>100 Black Men of Prince George's County, Inc.</u></a>	\$15,000	100 Black Men of Prince George's County will use grant funds for expenses related to presenting fifteen \$1,000 scholarships annually to eligible Prince George's County high school graduates at its community brunch event.
<a href="#"><u>Allentown Boys and Girls Club, Inc.</u></a>	\$1,000	Allentown Boys and Girls Club, Inc. - Fort Washington Branch will use grant funds for expenses related to support a program of activities that will expose our county's children to positive experiences that aid growth and development. More specifically, funds will be used to pay for registration and rental fees for events and meetings, Performance Enhance Equipment purchases, and experiential education costs such as transportation and hotels.
<a href="#"><u>ARC of Prince George's County</u></a>	\$1,000	ARC of Prince George's County will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting all of its program activities in support of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities. More specifically, the funds will be used for costs in arts and recreation, for transportation, to hire a new job developer, for expanding workshops, internships and job training for transitioning youth, and adding a new Project SEARCH site in the northern part of the county in the next 18 months.
<a href="#"><u>Charles Drew Memorial Scholarship Fund</u></a>	\$1,000	The Charles Drew Memorial Scholarship Fund will use grant funds for expenses related to continuing funding scholarships to students of Prince George's County and providing funding for the Project Enrich Program.
<a href="#"><u>Coalition for African Americans in the Performing Arts (CAAPA)</u></a>	\$1,000	Coalition for African Americans in the Performing Arts will use grant funds for expenses related to developing and implementing the Music Scholarship Program for graduating seniors in 12th Grade and for students in Grades 9-11 for a mentoring program.
<a href="#"><u>Diamond Foundation (No Website)</u></a>	\$5,000	Diamond Foundation will use grant funds for expenses related to implementing three community projects: a coat drive, a school supply drive, and a mentorship program that will impact disadvantaged youth ages 5-18.
<a href="#"><u>National Capital Baptist Convention, DC Vicinity (No Website)</u></a>	\$15,000	National Capital Baptist Convention, DC Vicinity will use grant funds for expenses related to its food drive on January 21, 2019, Martin Luther King Day.
