Organization Name	Amount	Grant Purpose
A Wider Circle	\$1,500	A Wider Circle will use grant funds for expenses related to operating the Essential Support Program, which provides items such as furniture, home goods, professional attire and school supplies to more than 16,000 individuals each year.
Art Works Studio School, Inc.	\$2,000	Art Works Studio School will use grant funds to support their visual arts education programs at Thomas Stone and Mount Rainier Elementary Schools. Grant funds will be used for operating expenses such as staffing and supplies which Art Works Studio School provides.
B-Roll Media and Arts, Inc.	\$1,000	B-Roll Media and Arts will use grant funds for expenses related to support free of cost media arts training and education to under-resourced youth ages 13-21 and youth with diagnosed learning disabilities in Prince George's County, Maryland.
City of Hyattsville- Summer Reading Program	\$2,000	The City of Hyattsville will use grant funds for expenses related to its Summer Reading Program. Funds will be used to purchase materials for craft activities, books, background checks for volunteers and honorariums for bilingual coordinators.
Coalition for African Americans in the Performing Arts (CAAPA)	\$2,500	Coalition for African Americans in the Performing Arts will use grant funds for expenses related to developing and implementing The Performance Series, Movin' On Up Youth and the Great Migration Program for families, students and children of all ages.
Community Legal Services	\$1,000	Community Legal Services of Prince George's County will use grant funds expenses related to operating its several clinics in Suitland, Greenbelt, Langley Park and Upper Marlboro, outreach to seniors, addressing domestic violence and conducting its Foreclosure Prevention Project, as well as providing its other services.
Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) / Prince George's County	\$5,000	Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) / Prince George's County will use grant funds for expenses related to advocating for physical health, mental health, safe housing, and the educational and social needs of 180 foster children and youth in foster care.
Engaged Community Offshoots, Inc.	\$2,000	Engaged Community Offshoots will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting its staff in demonstrating the many community benefits of producing, and educating about healthy food in Prince George's County.
First Generation College Bound, Inc.	\$4,500	First Generation College Bound will use grant funds for expenses related to conducting the following programs: Homework Club, Great Minds Great Futures Academy, College Access and College Retention.
Food & Friends, Inc.	\$2,000	Food & Friends will use grant funds for expenses related to medically-tailored, home-delivered meals to those who are too ill to procure or prepare food on their own. Funds will also be used for individualized nutrition counseling, including cooking classes, educational handouts, and presentations on nutrition related to cancer, diabetes, HIV / AIDS and other life-challenging illnesses.
Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc.	\$1,000	Housing Initiative Partnership will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting HIP's Rapid Rehousing Program, which provides intensive counseling, education and support to families transitioning out of homelessness.

Maryland International Corridor Community Development Corp.	\$29,500	Maryland International Corridor Community Development Corporation, dba Northern Gateway CDC, will use grant funds for expenses related to ongoing CDC functions and programs to mitigate the Purple Line's impact on small businesses and residents, beautify the landscape and improve economic opportunity and quality of life.
Mary's Center for Maternal and Child Care, Inc.	\$3,000	Mary's Center for Maternal and Child Care will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting wellness visits for uninsured and under-insured participants in Prince George's County.
NAMI Prince George's County, MD, Inc.	\$2,000	NAMI Prince George's County, MD, Inc. will use grant funds for expenses related to defraying costs for general operating support in its efforts to provide mental health related programs of support, education and advocacy for County residents.
Prince George's Arts and Humanities Council	\$25,000	Prince George's Arts and Humanities Council will use grant funds for expenses related to providing project management, programming, logistics and brand marketing services to the Gateway Arts District. More specifically, funds will be used for the preparation of materials and the provision of services which will promote the arts and entertainment district and engage its stakeholders over time.
Prince George's County Police Athletic League, Inc.	\$10,000	Prince George's County Police Athletic League will use grant funds for expenses related to conducting its programs. More specifically, funds will be used to purchase supplies and equipment unique to each program (baseball, tennis, martial arts, basketball, and Leadership & Life Summer Camp).
Prince George's Parks and Recreation Foundation, Inc.	\$2,000	Prince George's Park and Recreation Foundation will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting its annual toy drives at the Rollingcrest- Chillum Community Center and the North Brentwood Community Center.
Prince George's Police Department D1- Citizens Advisory Council	\$1,000	Prince George's County Police District 1 Citizens Advisory Council will use grant funds for expenses related to maintaining and enhancing the police / community relationship and being proactive with growing issues concerning public safety in Police District 1. More specifically, funds will be used for general administrative and coordination functions, for events such as National Night Out, Talk with a Cop and Shop with a Cop within Councilmanic District 2, as well as for Police Athletic League and Police Explorers Chapter 1111 activities / events.
St. Ann's Center for Children, Youth and Families	\$1,000	St. Ann's Center for Children, Youth and Families will use grant funds for expenses related to serving homeless women with young children in St. Ann's Transitional Housing Program, the majority of whom are from Prince George's County.
World Arts Focus, Inc. dba Joe's Movement Emporium	\$2,000	World Arts Focus, Inc. dba Joe's Movement Emporium will use grant funds for expense related to conducting its "Resilient Cultures" Joe's 2018-2019 season program for Onstage at Joe's.
