Organization Name	Amount	Grant Purpose
ARC of Prince George's County, Inc.	\$3,000	ARC of Prince George's County will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting all program activities carried out by the ARC of Prince George's County in support of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
Capital Area Food Bank	\$2,000	Capital Area Food Bank will use funds for expenses related to supporting the cost of its work in Prince George's County, including but not limited to staff salaries, benefits, costs of procuring and delivering food and materials and distribution costs.
Circle of Rights, Inc.	\$2,000	Circle of Rights will use grant funds for expenses related to WIC recipients to prepare nutritious meals minimizing their family's risk of stroke.
Coalition for African Americans in the Performing Arts (CAAPA)	\$2,000	Coalition for African Americans in the Performing Arts will use grant funds for expenses related to developing and implementing the "Sing for Seniors" recitals for senior citizens, retired individuals, and the disabled, hospice and aging community.
Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men	\$2,000	Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men will use grant funds for expenses related to providing annual scholarships to Prince George's County high school seniors and providing food and monetary donations to families in need of assistance that live in the county.
Community Legal Services of Prince George's County, Inc.	\$5,000	Community Legal Services of Prince George's County will use grant funds for expenses related to operating its Suitland Clinic outreach to seniors, addressing domestic violence and conducting its Foreclosure Prevention Project, as well as providing its other services.
Derek Anthony Moore Charity, Inc. (DAMCI)	\$1,500	Derek Anthony Moore Charity will use grant funds for expenses related to supplementing the funding of existing and expanded programs benefiting low-income families within Prince George's County. More specifically, funds will be used for the summer and fall camps for children; for youth conflict resolution, anti-bullying and anti-violence seminars; for youth and young adult career development, workforce readiness training and entrepreneurship programs; and for domestic and family violence programs impacting children.
District Heights Youth Development Foundation, Inc.	\$10,000	District Heights Youth Development Foundation will use grant funds for expenses related to providing a salary, stipend and supplies for a part-time licensed clinician and an intern to provide counseling services to children ages 3 - 5 years old, twice per week, in Theraplay treatment groups no larger than ten.
PTA Maryland Congress of Parents / Eleanor Roosevelt HS PTSA	\$1,000	Eleanor Roosevelt HS PTSA will use grant funds for expenses related to providing graduating senior high school students a memorable and safe event in which to have fun in an alcohol-free, smoke-free, drug-free and weapon-free environment to celebrate their graduation.
Food & Friends, Inc.	\$3,000	Food & Friends will use grant funds for expenses related to providing medically-tailored, home-delivered meals to those who are too ill to procure or prepare food on their own, as well as providing individualized nutrition counseling which includes cooking classes, educational handouts and presentations on nutrition related to cancer, diabetes, HIV / AIDS and other life-challenging illnesses.
Hope Connections for Cancer Support	\$1,500	Hope Connections for Cancer Support will use grant funds for expenses related to supplementing its current programming in Prince George's County with additional Gentle Yoga and Pink Ribbon Pilates classes, as well as providing an interactive nutrition workshop.
Maryland State Tigers Youth	\$1,000	Maryland State Tigers Youth Development will use grant funds for expenses related to obtaining facility use rental permits, printing materials and information content packages, stipends for the instructor and a working lunch for each instructor during each training session.

NAMI Prince George's County, MD, Inc.	\$2,000	NAMI Prince George's County will use grant funds for expenses related to conducting programs of support, education community outreach and a helpline for county residents. More specifically, funds will be used for general operating support.
New Horizons Supported Services, Inc.	\$2,000	New Horizons Supported Services will use grant funds for expenses related to increasing access to community-based, recreational activities for 34 adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) living in Councilmanic District 6. More specifically, the funds will support staffing and transportation costs.
Pickett Fences Senior Services, Inc.	\$2,000	Pickett Fences Senior Services will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting Dementia Friendly America - Prince George's initiative in South County, specifically Councilmanic District 6.
Prince George's County Police Athletic League, Inc.	\$3,000	Prince George's County Police Athletic League (PAL) will use grant funds for expenses related to directly funding PAL programs. Each program requires supplies and equipment unique to that program. Programs include baseball, basketball, Girls Can't Do What, Leadership & Life Summer Camp and martial arts.
Prince George's County Police T.E.P., Inc. (Triad, Explorers and PAL) (no website)	\$3,000	Prince George's County Police T.E.P. will use grant funds for expenses related to operating and growing the Prince George's County Police Explorer Program. More specifically, funds will be used to re-charter through Learning for Life and the Boy Scouts of America, for tee shirts, for training and national competitions, and for other activities throughout the year.
Prince George's County Public Safety Assistance Program, Inc. (no website)	\$3,000	Prince George's County Public Safety Assistance Program will use grant funds for expenses related to purchasing poultry, produce, canned goods and bread to fill Christmas food baskets.
Prince George's Cultural Arts Foundation	\$5,000	Prince George's Cultural Arts Foundation will use grant funds for expenses related to producing the 10th Annual Lake Arbor Jazz Festival.
Prince George's Cultural Arts Foundation	\$1,000	Prince George's Cultural Arts Foundation will use grant funds for expenses related to providing college scholarships and music workshops.
Prince George's Philharmonic	\$2,000	Prince George's Philharmonic will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting its educational outreach programs and its increased production costs of Philharmonic concerts during the 2018 -2019 season. This includes the season finale performance of Gustav Holst's <i>The Planets</i> in Dekelboum Concert Hall at the Clarice Smith Performing Arts Center.
Prince George's Tennis & Education	\$1,000	Prince George's Tennis & Education Foundation will use grant funds for expenses related to providing college scholarships for eligible high school graduates and program scholarships for eligible disadvantaged students in Prince George's County.
Scholastic Olympics	\$1,000	Scholastic Olympics will use grant funds for expenses related to hosting afterschool study sessions to prepare Councilmanic District 6 students for rigorous classroom academic work and the Scholastic Olympic contests. College students will be trained to conduct the sessions.
St. Ann's Center for Children, Youth and Families	\$1,000	St. Ann's Center for Children, Youth and Families will use grant funds for expenses related to serving homeless women with young children in St. Ann's Transitional Housing Program, the majority of whom are from Prince George's County. More specifically, funds will provide salary support for staff supporting this important program and who are intrinsic to the wrap-around care of Transitional Housing families.
Charles Drew Memorial	\$15,000	The Charles Drew Memorial Scholarship Fund will use grant funds for expenses related to continuing to fund scholarships to students of Prince George's County and to provide funding for the Project Enrich Program.
The Foundation for the Advancement of Music & Education, Inc. (FAME)	\$20,000	The Foundation for the Advancement of Music & Education (FAME) will use grant funds for expenses related to support the FAME Jazz Band's community performances, music theory tutoring and the trip to represent Maryland and Prince George's County at the Berklee College High School Festival in Boston, Massachusetts.
The Ivy Community Charities of Prince George's County, Inc.	\$2,000	The Ivy Community Charities of Prince George's County will use grant funds for expenses related to support scholarships for high school seniors who graduate from Councilmanic District 6 schools or who live in Councilmanic District 6.

The Training Source, Inc.	\$3,000	The Training Source will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting the following programs: Comprehensive Employment Training, Youth Leadership, Professional Skills Training and Community Supportive Services.
