<a href="#">Allentown Boys and Girls Club - Fort Washington Branch</a>	\$2,000	Allentown Boys and Girls Club - Fort Washington Branch will use grant funds for expenses related to maintaining the presence of positive activities in the lives of its club members and their families. More specifically, funds will be used for expenses for events in Richmond, Virginia, Atlantic City, New Jersey, and Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
<a href="#">Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men (CCBCM)</a>	\$1,000	Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men (CCBCM) will use grant funds for expenses related to providing annual scholarships to eligible Prince George's County high school seniors and to provide food and monetary donations to county families in need of assistance.
<a href="#">Community Legal Services of Prince George's County, Inc.</a>	\$3,000	Community Legal Services of Prince George's County will use grant funds for expenses related to general operating expenses, providing additional support to current programs and provide additional assistance to Prince George's County residents. Additionally, the funds will help respond to the county's high rates of foreclosure and domestic violence.
<a href="#">Ebenezer AME Stone of Help Community Development Corporation (no website)</a>	\$7,500	Ebenezer AME Stone of Help Community Development Corporation will use grant funds for expenses related to partnering with the church's Women's Resource & Restoration Center to assist women and families in crisis, as well as working with a young ladies life skills program to advance their overall well-being.
<a href="#">NAMI Prince George's County, MD, Inc.</a>	\$3,383	NAMI Prince George's County will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting educational programs, community outreach programs and a helpline for county residents.
<a href="#">National Congress of Black Women, Inc. - Prince George's County Chapter</a>	\$3,000	National Congress of Black Women, Inc. - Prince George's County Chapter will use grant funds for expenses related to paying for transportation for victims of abuse who have a need to visit doctors or hospitals.
<a href="#">Open My Heart Foundation, Inc.</a>	\$1,000	Open My Heart Foundation will use grant funds for expenses related to conducting the Red Dress Gala Awards event, which honors heart attack and stroke survivors and provides a monetary stipend for medical expenses, and the Heart Health Fair, which educates the public regarding heart disease, including eating healthy food and eliminating healthy food disparity.

(Triad, Explorers & PAL) will use grant funds for expenses related to hosting its "We Are One Community Day." Expenses include the activities, food, drinks and awards associated with the day.
<a href="#">The Better Family, Inc.</a>	\$8,000	The Better Family, Inc. will use grant funds to support a community based, free admission program (The Tots to Teens Expo) held within Prince George's County.
<a href="#">The Denney House, Inc.</a>	\$3,000	The Denney House (TDH) will use grant funds for expenses related to supporting its TDHWorks Program. The program is designed to develop in youths ages 16-24 core competencies related to career, college and financial literacy.
