









1. From District 1 to District 2 -- Move 3,173 people (two precincts) in Adelphi.
2. From District 3 to District 5 – Move 2,958 people (one precinct) in Landover Hills.
3. From District 4 to District 6 – Move 2,250 people (1 partial precinct already split) but leads to splitting of Bowie.
4. From District 9 to District 8 – Move 3,743 people, one precinct from Fort Washington and one precinct from western Accokeek, thereby splitting Accokeek.


## Move of Two Adelphi-based Precincts from District 1 to District 2




## Move of Precinct Encompassing Landover Hills from District 3 to District 5




**Move of One Precinct from Bowie,
