Central Kenilworth Avenue Revitalization Community Development Corporation	\$75,000	Central Kenilworth Avenue Revitalization Community Development Corporation will use grant funds to help fund its Health and Wellness programs and to allow it to expand its community outreach in Greater Riverdale.
Coalition for Public Safety Training in Schools, Inc.	\$40,000	Coalition for Public Safety Training in Schools, Inc., will use grant funds to offer services to youth, including driver education scholarships, a summer internship, leadership development, life skills, and a pre-apprenticeship program to enhance workforce development and improve quality of life.
Community Crisis Services, Inc.	\$75,000	Community Crisis Services, Inc. will use grant funds to supplement other safety net services to ensure all crisis/suicide calls are answered, all request for shelter are honored and that they develop an effective 911 Diversion Program.
First Generation College Bound, Inc.	\$180,000	First Generation College Bound, Inc. will use grant fund for general operating expenses in FY23.
In Reach, Inc.	\$25,000	In Reach, Inc., will use grant funds to produce Season 4 of Teen Talk Television and to expand Teen Talk Network. More specifically, funds will be used to fund staffing (interns, consultants, contractors) and for advertising, the two areas most instrumental in the success of the program.
Operation Earnie's Plate, Inc.	\$65,000	Operation Earnie's Plate Inc will use grant funds to support the general operations of the food pantry, including providing Thanksgiving box to residents of District 9 and the surrounding communities.
